Roller Foot

This foot includes built-in rollers (one at the front of the foot, and 2 smaller ones on the underside of the foot) to help feed difficult-to-sew fabrics such as leather, suede and vinyl.

Machine Preparation

- Attach Roller Foot.
- Manually lead the thread from the needle through the opening of the foot, and then slip the thread under and behind the foot.
- Set machine for Straight Stitch.
- Set the stitch length for a medium-long to long setting.

 Note: If the stitch setting is set too short, this could cause perforation of the leather vinyl or suede. It is recommended to first try the stitch on a scrap to test.

Sewing Instructions

- 1. Use double-faced (basting) tape to hold the fabric pieces together for sewing. This will help prevent either layer from slipping while sewing.
- 2. Place fabric under the presser foot. Lower the presser foot.
- 3. Sew, following the desired seam guide line. When sewing leather, suede or vinyl, the seam allowances can then be either topstitched down or glued (with fabric glue) for finishing purposes.
